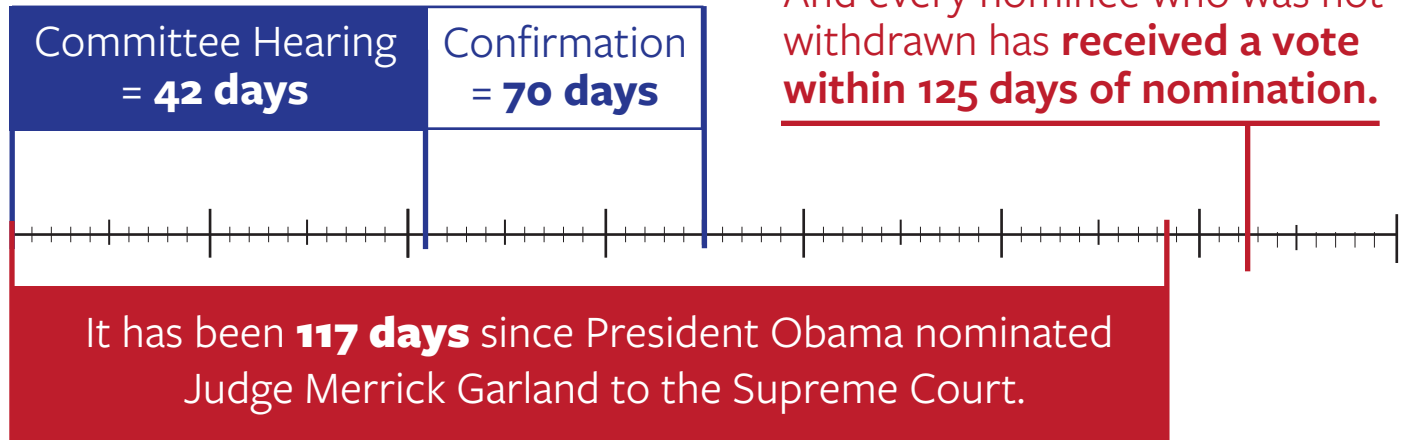


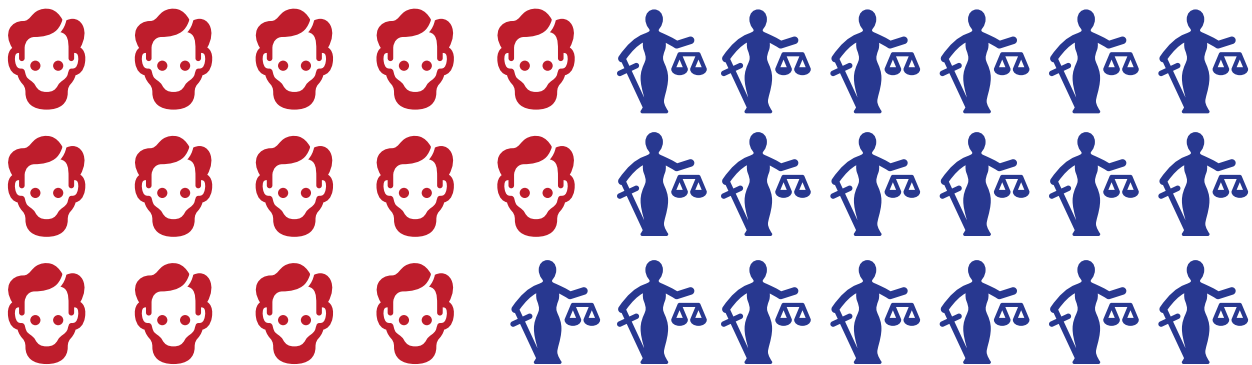
THE FACTS: SCOTUS NOMINEES

Since 1875, **every** Supreme Court nominee who was not withdrawn has received a Senate hearing or a vote.

Since 1975, the average time from nomination to hearing & confirmation has been:



14 Presidents have had **19 Nominees** confirmed to SCOTUS during a presidential election year.



That's **1/3 of Presidents,**
including President Reagan, whose appointee,
Justice Kennedy, was confirmed in 1988.
